New ILPA Project

ILPA has received funding from the Joseph Rowntree Charitable Trust for us to increase the use of our expertise in support of refugee and migrant community organisations and other NGOs in the sector. This information sheet provides details of that project, what support is available and how organisations may access that support.

Key aims of the project

The key aims of the project are to make available:

- regular updates on legal developments, and campaigning points, on the full range of immigration and asylum law and practice;
- discussion on legal issues;
- assistance with focus upon lobbying activities;
- training on matters of law, practice and lobbying.

Immigration Updates

ILPA will produce “immigration updates” at least once per month. These will be available on the ILPA website at www.ilpa.org.uk/infoservice.html or choose the “info service” link on the homepage.

Immigration updates will provide a very brief note on significant developments in the areas of immigration and asylum. These developments will include such things as changes in the law, changes in Home Office policy or practice, proposals on legal aid and formal consultations. They will also highlight selected events that may be of interest to readers.

Information Sheets

ILPA will also produce “information sheets”. These will also be available on the ILPA website in the same way as immigration updates (see above).

Information sheets will give more detail on one particular issue. The sorts of issues that may be covered will be as diverse as those covered in the updates. Usually, issues highlighted in an immigration update will also be dealt with by an information sheet – so if something in the updates is of particular interest, you may want to have a look at the relevant information sheet.
